

2012 Camper Guidelines

We want your child to have the best summer camp experience possible! Please read the guidelines below so that you and your child are prepared for days of fun ahead!

Every Day Needs: (please label everything with your child's name)

- Lunch
- Afternoon snack
- Water Bottle with water - preferably a reusable bottle
- Sunscreen & Bug Repellent- apply before you come to camp & send along the bottle for re-application
- Towel
- Poncho or rain jacket
- Backpack

How To Dress For Camp:

Camp can be messy - it happens! Please make sure that your child is dressed comfortably each day in the clothing suggestions listed below.

- On Monday, bring a change of clothes in a labeled Ziploc bag that can be left in the classroom for the week. This will be available in cases of extreme soilage or accidents.
- comfortable clothing that can get dirty
- closed toe shoes (sneakers or hiking boots- no crocs or sandals, please)
- a hat or visor

Special Themed- Day Needs:

Wednesday- Hike & creek playtime

- wear a sturdy pair of hiking shoes,
- bring closed-toed, over- the- heel water shoes (no flip flops)
- pack a backpack with a water bottle, lunch & beverage
- Include a hand towel and bag for wet items

Friday- Fishing and Fire Department Water War

- wear a swimsuit under regular camp clothes
- bring a water gun labeled with your name
- send a change of dry clothes & undies, shoes, socks and a towel



Gift Shop:

Wednesday and Thursday snack times will offer opportunities for campers to shop in the gift shop. Our shop offers a wide variety of nature-themed items and toys for children. Should you choose to send money with your camper, money will be put into an envelope, labeled and held by camp staff until the designated time.

Snacks: Fruit drinks and water are served everyday during snack time. A special ice pop snack is served Wednesdays.

Camper Expectations & Behavior:

- use soft voices and feet when around the animals

- run inside the building
- remove items from the trail
